RCM Report- NASU ASC, February 2022

Hello Area,

- Open positions at Region: Vice-Chair, Vice Treasurer, H&I Vice-Chair, and PR Vice-Chair.
- PR Chair will be open for nominations at the May RSC.
- Regional PR Committee would like to place Bus Cards & Posters in Shelters with the NA Helpline phone number, just like we do here in the So. Utah Area and needs a vote from our GSRs.

Bus and Shelter Prices

Bus Cards:

2 cards on 50 buses =100 cards
 Production for 100 cards \$1,000
 Cost to place on 50 buses \$1,000
 Campaign-90 days
 Total cost =\$2,000

Shelters:

10 shelters= 10 Posters
 Production cost =\$900
 Cost of space on shelter=\$500
 Campaign 60 days

Total cost =\$1,400

PR will be reviewing the influx of calls after the 90 campaign to try and track results.

Our Regional Treasurer has recommended that I emphasize the increase in yearly cost, which is upwards of an additional \$4000 a year, not including start-up costs.

Regional PR's remaining budget right now is about \$11,648. If this passes, their yearly budget would be increased to \$15,000.

Regional budgets will be done in July, which would be a good time to add such a large increase.
