TREASURER'S REPORT - Jeri D

Hello NASU,

Thomas will be talking about an accounting error that happened before my time. The books are going to be audited, Thomas believes he has figured out the issue. No money is "missing" We actually have \$412.18 more in the bank than the spreadsheet reflects. I have added that to the spreadsheet to make it accurate.

Ok, I am going to be going over a bunch of numbers, I have tried to keep it as simple as possible. Ok, SUACNA made a deposit of \$10,000 on June 28th. This leaves us with a balance of \$22,164.65 minus both our prudent \$1,000 & operating reserves of \$3,000 we have an available balance of \$18,164.65. Our sub-committee budgets are \$12,920.42. So, if I have this right, that means that \$12,920.42 is not actually the ASC's money to spend, rather it is allocated to the sub-committees. If we take the available balance and deduct the sub-committee money, we are left with \$5,244.23. This is without the motion that previously passed for a grill and generator.

Zoom's prices went up again. In May it was \$33.96. In June & July, it was \$34.14, a \$.18 increase. So each sub-Committee is now paying \$.09 more. It has gone up \$2.31 since January. The sub-committees have the following money remaining in their budget, see below.

On June 5th, I unintentionally shorted a transfer to SUACNA. The deposit was for \$518.43 I transferred \$518.18. This is a \$.25 difference.

I did reach out to SUACNA's new committee members to do some bank changes, and I have not been responded to.

I am going to make a motion to send Region \$2,500.

-There is \$412.15 more in the account than the spreadsheet shows. Upon investigation, this amount comes from a time at area when the checkbook was forgotten so cash was used, and the bus ad was put on twice and should have only been once. The discrepancy has been accounted for.

-The entire Venmo account transactions will be gone through. By Mikey and Angie S.

-It was discussed that someone needs to be accountable for the generator care. The storage unit keeper will be taking on this position and will find out if it can be stored with gas in it or not. A list of rules for care and maintenance will be typed up by Aubrey this will also include how many hours it was running so that it will be easier to know when to change the oil. Lost and Found will be ordering the generator and will forward that information to the treasurer.

-Storage unit ad-hoc that was made in May has not met yet. It was reported that they will be meeting soon to create the guideline for this position, including generator care.
