H&I - Jason R

Hello Nasunians.

H&I is doing well, and we are looking forward to the next year. With relaxed covid restrictions, we hope to reach further facilities, as long as the attendance stays up within the committee and we have a lot of support!

All facilities are great!

We had a panel member step down, but we now have a new nomination and panel leader Kodi M (which-somehow- by not saying the entire last name keeps her more anonymous) We want to put the word out that Iron County Jail needs support for holding meetings. They are currently not under H&I guidelines, but there are meetings being held. To bring it under the guidelines, we need Male and Female help, as well as 2 people per meeting. Let's get people approved for going to jail!

Our budget was proposed and voted on, that we would like to bring to the area, and then back to the groups.

We are basing it off of last year's numbers, and taking into account the increase of facilities, as well as supplying the jails with more literature.

\$800 for literature (we spent nearly all of the \$600 for literature last year, with our last purchase to supply Iron County with some basics etc.) With the increase in facilities reached, and the re supply this year we expect to use that as well. It is a very very important part of our primary purpose- to carry the message to the addict.

\$500 for gas. With just crossover travel alone, it was estimated that \$50 a month was spent on gas. We feel no one being of service should feel as though they cannot be of service due to financial restraints, if we (and we hope to) create a panel for Iron Country Jail, that is more travel to be done. We feel \$500 may not cover gas for an entire year, but it does help those in these service groups.

\$300 for an event. We based this off of last years request for \$500, and the usage of only \$150 of that. This year we..... are planning on a breakfast for books (great alliteration skills) and this would cover the food cost etc. Of course when the time comes, we can have a further breakdown of what exactly we would spend once it's all planned, and then it goes back to groups, so dont worry! It wont just disappear. The event would fundraise money to go back to area, and help with literature costs.

\$200 Miscellaneous- We need supplies. Binders for each facility, cover sheets for the readings. We would request any miscellaneous needs through area of course.
