## **TREASURER'S REPORT - Jeri D**

Hello ASC,

Good afternoon! The passwords have been updated for all of the accounts that the treasurer deals with.

Thomas and I went through and set a budget for the Executive Committee. We accounted for all of our recurring expenses, as well as a \$1,100 cushion for unforeseen expenses. Last year we purchased a laptop for the secretary and the hotspot and speakers for the zoomers! Those are the types of expenses we were trying to account for.

Thomas got us all squared away with the hotspot aka Mi-Fi so that the chair and the secretary can have reliable access to the internet for the zoomers. While Thomas was at the T-Mobile store he inquired about a solution to the Venmo situation. The solution was that if we obtained a small tablet for the treasurer we could get a phone number associated with that tablet and move the Venmo account to that. That way it is not tied to one person, but instead to NA as a whole.

The tablet would be Alcatel Joy Tab 2. It would cost \$168 + \$35 for the activation. That will give this tablet 500 MB of data that's all that we would need. Most people have Wi-Fi, and now ASC will have that as well. If we went ahead with the purchase of the tablet it would cost \$5/month (with automatic payments).

This could also be the solution to SUACNA's Venmo issues. They could purchase their own tablet for this very reason. SUACNA's account would be \$200 for the tablet. Their monthly service fee would be \$10/month for 2GBs of data. They will need more since they go to various events that most likely do not have Wi-Fi.

We will figure out a time to get together with the co-treasurer and anyone else needing to be added to the bank. We will need to bring the minutes showing them as the newly voted members and go to the US Bank to be added to the account as authorized signatories. Also, remove all those that need to be removed.

It is also Tax time... Thomas and I will get that handled and will get all contact information changed over to Jeri.

We will need to obtain information from the newly elected members, we will need your government name, and address and you will need to sign a paper with your name on it. This is for our tax-exempt license. There will be a \$35 fee for this unless it went up from the last time we did this.

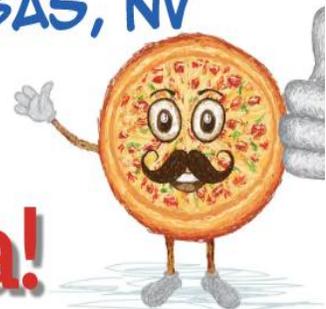
