## Open Forum

Shelly S & Paul talked about Bading - Concerns for the newcomers, less than 25 with less than 90 days. 1000 registration packets, 800 registered includes newcomers so many people that do not register and just come for the main event. Not that many institutions that actually show up.

There are events they can do to fund a newcomer account. The main principle here is being self supporting.

Costs - \$2500-3000 startup. Space rent \$22k before anything else. They made \$20k some of that will go back to the startup process and other monies will get sent up the service structure.

There are a lot of people that come to the convention are from out of town, Las Vegas is a huge attractor. Most people that show up on Saturday CAN afford to pay, but they chose not to. Some areas do a day pass. So there are alternative ways to make sure that no one is turned away.

Considerable amount more than years past, why would Region 51 need to "badge"? This convention has never before made money. They are not planning on this repeating. There are a lot of things that are due before the actual convention. Huge turnout with the auction. They made about \$6k. One member accounted for half of that. 2/3 of the money came from fundraising.

One member said maybe they should keep some of the money, instead of sending up the service structure. Point is well taken.

\$20 startup fund, also want to take \$1000 for a new POS fund. So that the money will be available immediately. The money they send up the service structure goes to the region. If the badging doesn't pass they will still have the convention.

Perhaps every area can have a fundraiser, and we can donate the money to the convention.

This convention was an anomaly if there comes a point where it doesn't make this kind of money, they might not have the convention. GSR vote: Passes.

Unfinished business:

Beaver meeting: Some members were concerned about the name of the meeting. Some people thought the name was inappropriate.

It is not right to go change a meeting name on the meeting lists its not right!

What about NA humpday, or the nooner

They are not breaking the traditions.

Each group is autonomous

It is the town moto.

On the meeting lists, it states the name of the meeting and the town, so people will know.

There were 3 people that started the meeting. Drug addicts do not have a place to go. They have the sister fellowship, and they are not welcomed there. Treatment centers are there, new comers are there. Started April 4 with 3 people and now there are 30 people every meeting.

The name was changed on the meeting lists, so this is a separate issue. PR changed the name.

Will talk about this again.
