PR REPORT June 17, 2017

Hello everyone!

600 June meeting lists were printed at a cost of \$122.57.

There were no changes to the meeting lists this month. Meeting lists were distributed to all GSR's present at the May ASC.

The website was updated with the current Meeting List and area minutes. Info West was updated with all the contact phone numbers and emails, as well as listing the Treasurer as the main contact along with the Area Chair. Also, old flyers from past events were removed. The website will be updated with the new H&I Chair, and the guidelines for the Entertainment Committee and the H&I Committee once they have been approved.

We have a bill due to renew our domain name. the options are: \$25 for one year, \$45 for 2 years or \$100 for 5 years. The PR committee believes the best option is the five years for \$100 to secure our domain name at the lowest cost while guaranteeing continuity. I will be making a motion for this and I will also discuss it during Open Forum.

An addict notified me that a social worker at the ER, (at Dixie Regional Hospital), had given her a meeting list dated 2015. We will visit the ER to rectify this issue.

The PR business meeting was held Wednesday June 14, 2017

I also picked up new posters for placement in the community. These posters were originally created in response to a request from the National Guard for an informational poster about Narcotics Anonymous for distribution to all Guard locations in the state. The PR Committee liked the poster and had forty printed at a cost of

Hello Area,

well we are finally done with the convention for the year and all i have to say is Thank you!!!. This year was one for the books and we couldn't have done it without you all. So a couple areas that I want to highlight. We had over 150 registrations before the convention, which was double the previous year. I think the commemorative medallion was a great bonus, but I lot came from members of the committee hustling. We considered another fundraiser, but decided lets focus on registrations and the last 3 weeks we brought in almost \$1,500. Next was the merchandise which sold out of almost everything that was there. we do have a few shirts left over, but most everything is gone. Thanks to all the home groups in the area that participated in the Sweet Shoppe Social. It was great to see so many involved. We dropped the number of banquets down from 10 at a table to 9 at a table to give more room and create more exclusivity. They sold out compared to last year where we had over 20 tickets remaining. The food was great, however the service was not. That is something we will address with any future hotels. The auction kicked but and we brought in about . The quilt alone was 1,300 and to my knowledge (correct me if I am wrong) was the highest item ever sold at the convention. And lastly the attendance for our sat night meeting had 335 people. It was the first time we have opened all the rooms in the Hilton Garden Inn and it was beautiful. and to make it even better there was over 2000 years of clean time in that room. I can not express my gratitude to everyone one of you. This was amazing. Lastly BST.... I have to say they truly the heart and soul of the convention.. the newcomers that are desperate to stay clean and they really worked for it and earned those days. Thank you. I really could go on and on and on, but since I am already doing that ill hurry. Some house cleaning. We are still accepting theme and logo submissions for next year and we will be voting on them on SUNDAY JUNE 25th. please email them to convention@nasouthernutah.org. The 25th will be our closing meeting, tying up any lose ends, giving final reports with all the deets. In addition to that, the very next week, the 2nd of JULY, we will be doing elections for new positions for the next convention. If you are wanting to take a position the majority of the positions are 1 year clean with some at 2 years. If you are wanting to run for Chair, we will vote there, and then that vote will come back to area on July 8th to have the home groups vote on it. So please come and be apart of. Lastly lets get down to the numbers. my last report we had 4,751. 15 as our balance. we had a lot go in and even more go out and we were sitting on about a 1,000 cushion before the convention. This was before the hotel got paid and everything. so like I mentioned the committed stepped up, and brought in almost 1500. At the day of the convention our balance was about 2,700. Monday the 12th after the convention we were sitting on 17, 200. After paying the hotel 4300 we are sitting on a balance TODAY of 12,718.32. Keep in mind there may be a few small things still pending, but that is close to where we will be The last meeting on the 25th will be final numbers and then the SUACNA committee can vote to make motions to

move funds to the area service body. Like I mentioned, this was a huge year and I am blessed to be apart of the fellowship of Narcotics Anonymous.

CCGC (Susan) Hello my beautiful people!! Our June 3rd event was awesome! We brought in \$175 from the event and I believe Thomas B deposited \$214 in the account. Part of that money was from the last campfire meeting. We really appreciate the support from down south! It was a great event! I will be putting in a motion for a reimbursement for the pavilion, which was \$15 and for the meat, which was \$27.86. We are having a campfire meeting tonight at 8:30 at the Southwest Wildlife Preserve. We also came up with a date for our annual camp out. August 5th and 6th. We will be having another business meeting Monday the 19th @ 7:15pm I guess it will be at the KKCB until we figure out if CCGC can get a key for the Southwest Center. This meeting is to start planning the camp out. We are also putting in a motion for \$275 for the camp out.
