Area Inventory Ad hoc Report October '17

The meeting took place October 12th at Leslie's house, and four people were in attendance. An area inventory is new territory for most of us, and especially the four in attendance. Why do we do an Area inventory? For the same reason as NA members do personal inventories: to stop, consider their actions and attitudes, and rededicate themselves to their ideals. The NA Guide to Local Services was used during our discussions and guided the meeting. Three questions we asked ourselves were:

1. How well has the area committee done this year at serving the groups, and how can it better serve them in the coming year?
2. How well has the area committee served the larger community, and how can the committee better the community-at-large?
3. How well has the area committee done at supporting NA's regional and world services?
How can the area provide better support for these services?

Much of the meeting's focus was on the first two questions. What we came up with is that our communications could be a whole lot better. More specifically, between the groups and area, area to the groups, and between sub committee's and GSR's. Written reports from sub committees could be more clear, and we used PR as an example. When PR brings a motion to the floor asking for Spanish literature, the motion needs to be more detailed. For instance, which locations will be receiving Spanish speaking literature? How much literature and what literature? When will the locations be stocked with literature? If sub committees can detail their communications, reports, and motions, then maybe the channel between them and GSR's and the ASC body will be more clear and less confusing. Reports from sub committees should provide three goals, and these goals should be specific: where, when, and how.

The ad hoc committee then looked at question 2 and how we could serve the community better. We answered this question by again looking at PR. We came up with ideas like:

1. Serve lunch at the soup kitchen with meeting lists
2. Presentations at schools
3. Coordinate presentations with The Elks Lodge in order to reach children
4. Reach out to tent city along the Virgin River

As far as the GSR's guiding the ASC and bringing their ideas, thoughts, frustrations, and needs to the ASC body, we feel the GSR's need to be better informed of their responsibilities, informed what they can and should communicate about to the ASC. The groups should guide and assist the ASC to better their primary purpose, and we feel the GSR's do not even know this, what that means, and how they go about it. The last ASC meeting in Cedar City, the GSR's communicated this and the solution was to have a Learning Days. We feel as an ad hoc committee, the Learning Days can and should incorporate these ideas.

The area inventory is far from being completed, but this is some of the things we have discussed.

PR REPORT November 11, 2017

Good evening everyone!

The web site has been updated with all the area minutes, up to date guidelines for all committees and meeting changes to reflect time changes such as Perks time and location and We-covery instead of Recovery Rainbow. Also, all the events have been updated and old one events have been removed.

500 November meeting lists were printed at a cost of \$102.36.

The Circle of Hope meeting moved back to Perks on Sunset Blvd. at 7:00 PM

October Meeting lists were distributed to GSR's . Lists were distributed throughout the community by Dave J. and Rosemary J.

The Phonenumber Coordinator stepped down so we are looking for a new Phone Line Coordinator

The PR business meeting was held today, November 11, 2017, because only one member of the committee was available during the usual scheduled time. This was due in part because of a scheduling conflict which I created. I apologize for this error and I will not let it happen again. Our normal scheduled time for the PR Business meetings are the Wednesday prior to Area. This means our next business meeting will be Wednesday December 6,2017.

The ads, called Blips, are 8 seconds each and would consist of the electronic version of our basic blue poster which says Drug Problem? Our phone line number and the words Narcotics Anonymous are at the bottom along with our NA symbol. \$10 per day would give us an average of 760 Blips each day during off peak hours of 7:00 PM until 9:00 AM

Intent: it says in the PR Handbook that the still suffering addict cannot hear our message if they don't know where to find us. It also says PR is charged with informing the public that we are a credible program of recovery. This billboard would demonstrate to the public that NA is an effective, professional organization. And it would also let the still suffering addict know there is hope and how to find it.
