Good afternoon ASC. Once again this month I was able to get my prints done at Alphagraphics. They were able to charge our card on file for \$13.76. I gave this receipt to Angie. I will be submitting another proposal today on behalf of our next secretary for the printing supplies next month. If the next secretary elected is from Cedar City then I will have her get a couple printing quotes from up there to see who is the cheapest.

This week I further prepared for the next secretary by typing up step-by-step instructions on how I prepare for area and type up the minutes. My hope is that this will be a good reference guide for anyone coming into the position that might be intimidated by the fast pace and volume of typing that is required. My notes are just simply how I do it & only meant to give guidance until you get your own routine down.

I am really excited to report that I was contacted by the Richfield group this month with their meeting times and area donation they attempted to make through Zelle. I have forwarded the information to the webservant to update their meeting times and I have also forwarded the email to the treasurer to sort out the Zelle situation.

I also received a text from policy this month inquiring about the new guidelines for SUACNA that were approved in October and why they aren't updated on the website. We came to the conclusion that once the changes were approved at area, the physical changes were never made and sent to the webservant. My question is what does that process look like and who is in charge of making the physical changes? Is it the subcommittee that sent in the proposal? Or does someone else help with typing these? I will be instructing the new secretary to keep up on our hard copy binder of the area guidelines for every subcommittee so I want to make sure we know where to find the correct copies of these.

Also, can we please update the guidelines that are appearing on our website? They are different depending on where you click to access them. If you click on "area committees" then click "guidelines download page" it shows you a document from the year 2022 that doesn't have those most recent changes that Mikey had got approved. For instance, we changed article V11 to say a quorum was 2/3rds of eligible voting members but then we changed it again to say a quorum is 51% of eligible voting members. So was that final copy ever sent to the webservant? If you click on "Area Committees" and then on "area executive committees" and then at the bottom you click on "N.A.S.U. guidelines new" you once again get a completely different version and this one is possibly even older because Article VII is not even called Voting procedures like it's supposed to be. And the third spot where I see different versions is if you click on

“downloads” then scroll down to “public archive” then click on “current documents” there is two old versions of our guidelines in there as well.

Next, I received a bunch of regional emails this month about business meetings and CAR reports and such but one that stood out was that the event they have planned in March up at Brian Head called Dopes on Slopes got changed to March 26-29, so you will want to update your calendars for that.

As always, if you have not been receiving the monthly minutes, please see me and get your email address added to the master list.

Regarding Zelle, we put in the report a while back that US Bank changed its policy and took Zelle away because this is a business account. Over the last couple weeks we have had two different people try to deposit money via Zelle transactions. One is from Ariel Miller on 1/28 for \$100 and I still do not know who that is. The other was for \$30.51 and we have figured out who that is. She emailed me and I let her know of the issue and told her I would bring it up at area to see if I could have her send it to my personal account and I could then deposit it into this one. 


