Open Forum

Rennie: Is submitting two proposals. The first one is for \$400 for the lake at the hill event on August 16th. \$200 for meat, \$100 for chips, \$100 for water/ice & fixins (buns, ketchup, mustard, mayo). We will be doing walking tacos, which is when you get a little chip bag and add the meat and cheese and everything to the chip bag. It was discussed that the majority of their events have over 100 people which is why the food costs so much and they have barely had enough food each time. The next proposal is for \$20 for the KKCB for rent for CCGC business meeting on 7/10 & 7/24. We have secured a storage unit at State Storage, unit #866, right now the lock is just a key but we will propose to purchase a new key code one here soon. The rent for this month is \$50.00 with a \$45 deposit. It was suggested that we split the storage unit position into 2 positions and just use the guidelines we already have in place. That way the Cedar position and can coordinate with the St George storage position and vice versa. It was discussed that this year the funds came out of the CCGC budget but next year the cost will be included in the Executive body budget just like our SG unit. Rennie will write up a proposal for a guideline change to have 2 coordinators for the Storage Unit wizard and will work with Policy and bring this back next month.

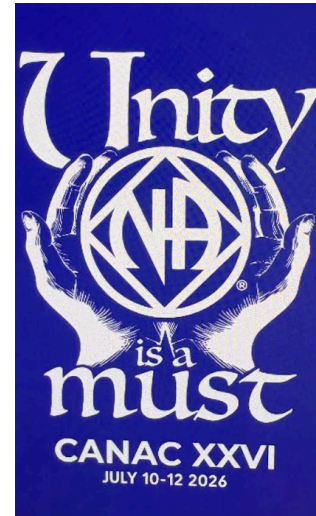
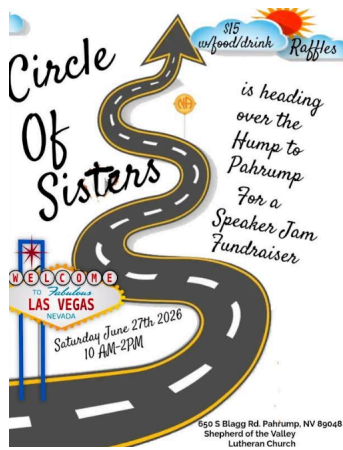

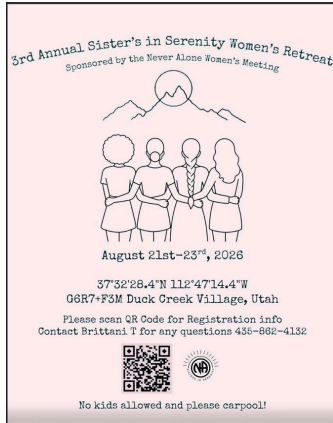
(b) Duties:
